BELGIUM

I will be present in the United States only for such period of time as may be reasonably or customarily required to effectuate the purpose of this visit.

I arrived in the United States on _____ (insert the date of the alien’s last arrival in the United States before beginning study at the United States educational institution). The treaty exemption is available for an unlimited time period for student employment compensation as long as all other requirements of the treaty are met. The maximum time limit for business training or an internship is two years beginning with the taxable year that includes my arrival date.
